

FRED WESTBERG MEMORIAL PICNIC PAVILION SHERMAN PARK

The Yakima Greenway is a 20-mile, 3600-acre land trust along the Yakima River and Naches River dedicated to conservation and recreation. Developed, maintained and operated by the nonprofit Yakima Greenway Foundation, the Greenway is not a part of the City or County parks systems. **No tax dollars are used!** The Foundation raises all moneys needed through fundraising events, donations from local service clubs, memorials, annual memberships and **reservations fees** for Greenway facilities.

use by Arboretum visitors only. **Drinking water:** please bring your own as water is not available from the Jewett Interpretive Center or other Arboretum facilities. **Sound:** the Arboretum hosts weddings and tours throughout the week; in order to preserve this pastoral environment, please keep music and noise levels from the picnic area to a minimum. **Visiting the Arboretum:** activities prohibited on Arboretum grounds include picnicking, walking pets, playing games,

flying kites, swimming, wading, climbing trees and other activities.
